

# 2015 Safest Places in New York



When deciding where to live, safety is a top priority. Our team at ValuePenguin has analyzed the most recent FBI Crime Report to determine the safety of cities and towns in New York. These 70 ranged in a crime score from 3 to 4,363, with an average of 801. We found that the five safest places to emerge were representative of the top 65 overall: they all classify themselves as towns as village.

More populous cities, including the eponymous New York, fell near the bottom of our rankings despite the fact that we adjusted our crime score metric for population, also taking into account both the amount of violent and property-related crimes per 100,000 people (more on our methodology below). # Select Safe Places in New York

These select cities have an average crime score of 91, 89% lower than their typical peer in New York. With some of the state's lowest total violent crime rates, these five are among the safest places in the state.

### 1. Elmira Town, N.Y.

With a motto of "it's a great place to live," we can certainly say it's a safe one. Reporting just one property crime for all of 2013, Elmira Town tops our list. Nestled in the Fingerlakes region, the small town shares its borders with the city of Elmira, which ranked 188th overall in crime score. Overseen by a supervisor and four councilmembers, the town reserves just one day a week for its court to be in session.

## 7. Glen Cove, N.Y.

Situated on Long Island's north shore, Glen Cove is the only non-town or -village to rank among the top 65 safest places in the state. The city is also the most populated of any of the top 20. Still connected to New York City by the Long Island Railroad, it was apart of the 1920s-famed Gold Coast, and the city remains a pricey living option; the average home value in 2012 was \$490,394, 75% higher than the state's average.

## 12. Tuckahoe Village, N.Y.

With a crime score that is 87% lower than that of the state's average city, Tuckahoe Village placed 12th in our study. Alleged criminal offenders here have little hiding places; the village is less than one square mile in size. It takes pride in its walkability and commuter-friendliness; it's almost equidistant from both White Plains to the north and New York City to the south. The village is actually a part of the town of Eastchester, which has 19,800 residents and ranked 25th in our study.

#### 14. New Castle Town, N.Y.

Another Westchester County member, New Castle Town broke into the top 15 having registered only two violent crimes for the year in question. It's less surprising that the town, which is very forthright with its arrest data, has struggled more with property-related crime. Its residents, who count Governor Andrew Cuomo among them, earn an estimated median household income of \$194,127, 244% higher than the state's average. The government's third-largest annual expenditure, too, is on public safety.

### 20. Kent Town, N.Y.

Located a 45-minute west of Rochester, Kent Town narrowly cracked the top 20 overall thanks to its relative lack of violent crime; it reported just one, a rape, to the FBI for all of 2013. The 11-officer police department has an unusual New York topography to deal with here, as the town is both rural and flush with rocky mountain ranges. With its many lakes and reservoirs, Kent Town supplies water to the more densely-populated cities on our list below.

# **Population Breakdown**

Although we adjusted for population in our crime rankings, it is still difficult to compare a small town to a large city. To account for this fact, we separated the safest cities into three categories: towns with populations between 5,000 and 10,000, midsize cities with populations between 10,000 and 20,000, and larger cities with populations greater than 20,000. Here are our findings:

# Methodology

To rank these places, we collected data from the 2013 FBI crime statistics by city, which provides the most recent crime data available. Not every town participates in this report and we also excluded towns with fewer than 5,000 residents because towns with small populations are more sensitive to crime score fluctuations for fewer crimes committed. The raw data report included property crimes (burglary, larceny-theft, motor vehicle theft, and arson), and violent crimes (murder/manslaughter, forcible rape, robbery, and aggravated assault) from all law enforcement agencies that chose to partake in the FBI Uniform Crime Reporting program.

We standardized the data to reflect violent and property crimes per 100,000, to account for population. Then, we aggregated a "crime score" by weighting violent crime at 90% and property crime at 10%. Though property crime is more prevalent, we figured that violent crime is more concerning to town residents. Then we adjusted the crime score for population size, giving more slack to larger cities. Finally, we ranked the cities based on their crime scores.
